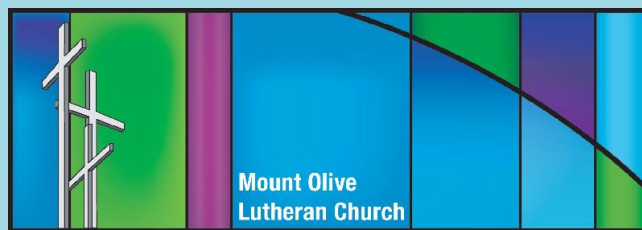


The Loop

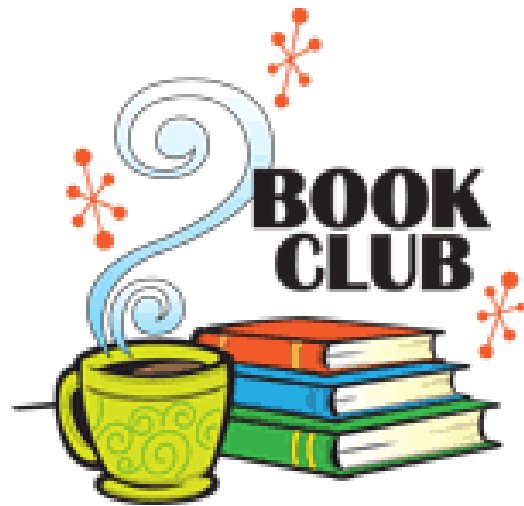
