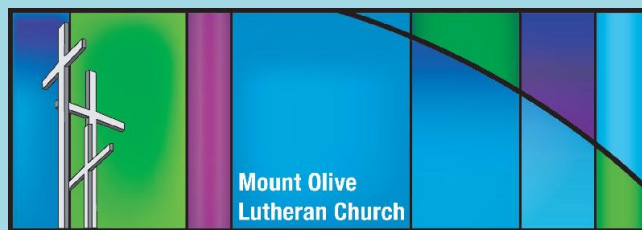


The Loop

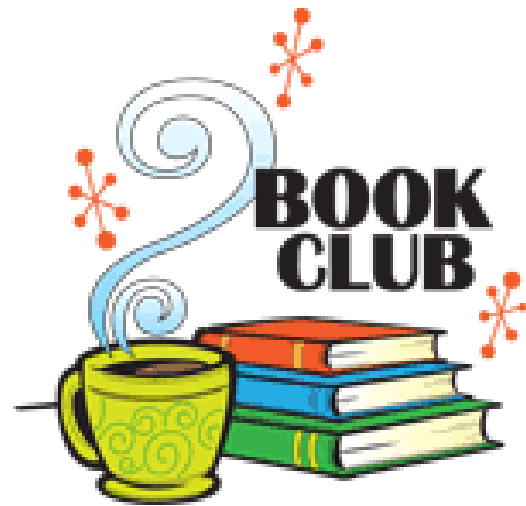
