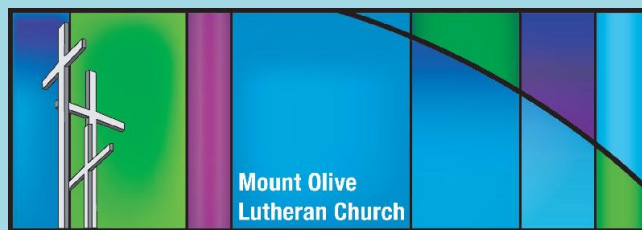


# The Loop
