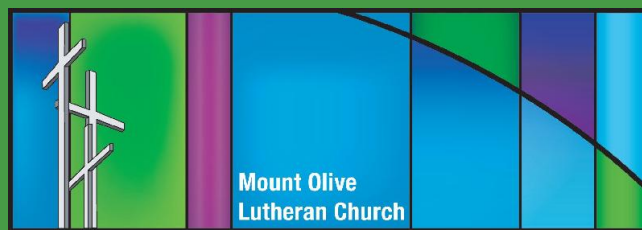


# The Loop

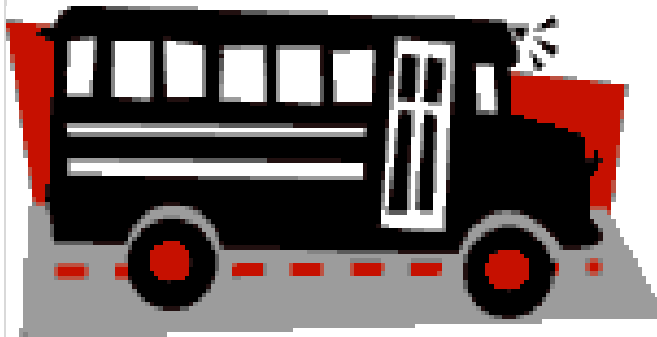
