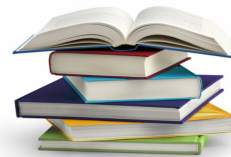

## “God is Love” Youth Group Event

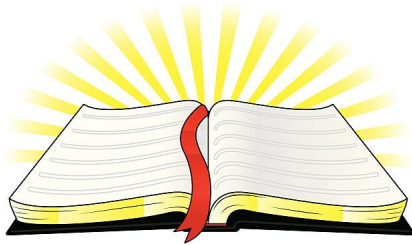

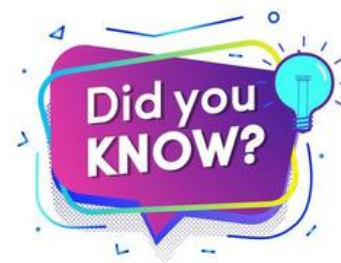
