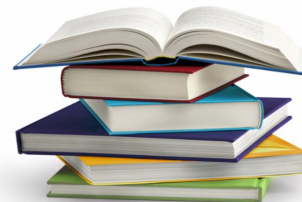

Calendar Exchange

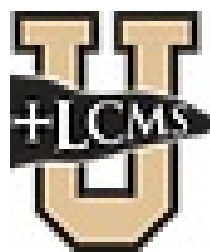
