A banquet will follow the service by invitation only. Watch for your invitation in the mail. RSVP by October 30th.

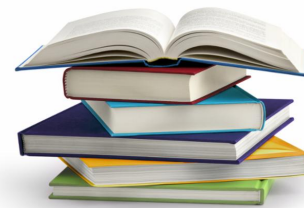
Please note: There will be no Saturday evening service on November 16th.

Saturday, Oct 12 - Asphalt work on North parking lot - can be driven on the same day but no cars should be parked in the North lot after 8am.

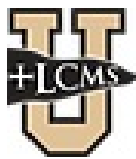
Saturday, Oct 12 - Crackseal on West and South parking lots - can be driven on the same day but no cars should be parked in the West or South lots after 8am.

Saturday, Oct 19 - Crackseal on North Parking Lot - visitors will have to park in the South lot.

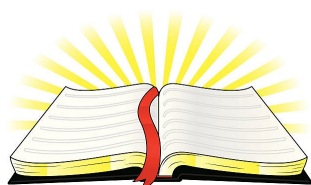
