




On a hill far away stood an old rugged cross, The emblem of suff'ring and shame; And I love that old cross, where the dearest and best For a world of lost sinners was slain.





A mighty fortress is our God, a sword and shield victorious; He breaks the cruel oppressor's rod and wins salvation glorious.






You ask who this may be? The Lord of Hosts is He. Christ Jesus, mighty Lord, God's only Son, adored. He holds the field victorious.




Though hordes of devils fill the land all threatening to devour us, We tremble not, unmoved we stand; they cannot overpow'r us.




Epistle Reading

Romans 3:19-28


Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God.



For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.



But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it— the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe.



For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith.

This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith. For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.


So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

Set us free by the truth You now bring us.


