This year is Mount Olive's 60th anniversary.

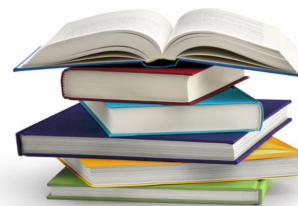
The celebration starts with a **1960s themed potluck party on Saturday, November 9th at noon**. Then during the week of November 10th, we will have several service projects happening.

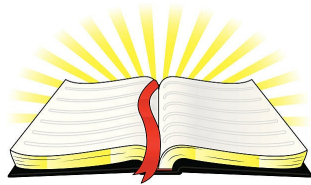
