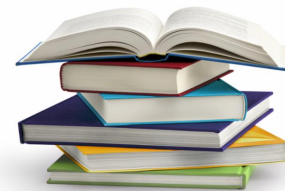

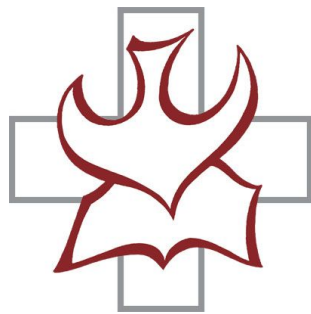

Confirmation Sunday

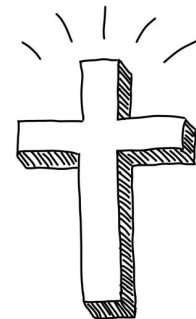
Confirmation is this Sunday during the 10:45 service.
