CHILDREN'S Sunday School

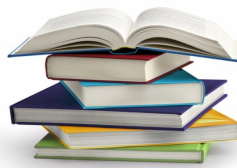

Stock the Shelves!

Aurora Interfaith feeds the hungry in Aurora and provides other supportive services. In 2025, they served 35,492 individuals, provided food for 452,817 meals and paid \$59,373 in utility fees for needy households.

During the month of **July**, we are doing a special food drive to help **stock the food shelves**. Food supplies are low during the summer months due to greater demand and decreased donations. Suggested items include canned fruits and vegetables, canned chicken or tuna, powdered milk, peanut butter, rice, pastas, granola bars, nuts, soups, whole grain cereal, toilet paper, paper towels, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo and conditioner. Look for the collection containers in the narthex and by the parish hall.
